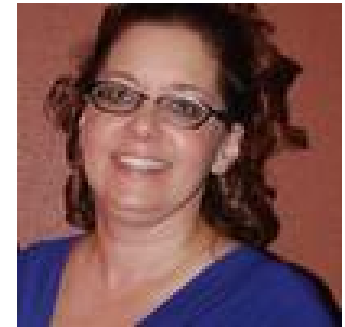

The new gTLD Program established auctions as a mechanism of last resort to resolve string contention. Most string contentions (approximately 90% of sets scheduled for auction) have been resolved through other means before reaching an auction conducted by ICANN's authorized auction service provider, Power Auctions LLC. However, it was recognized from the outset that significant funds could accrue as a result of several auctions. As such, these auction proceeds have been reserved and earmarked until the Board authorizes a plan for the appropriate use of the funds. Board, staff, and community are expected to be working together in designing and participating in the next steps addressing the use of new gTLD auction proceeds. It should be recognized though that these proceeds are to be considered as an exceptional, one-time source of revenue.

A drafting team composed of representatives of SO/ACs and the Board was convened to prepare a draft Charter. This group met for the first time on 10 Mar 2016 in Marrakech and has produced a draft charter which was reviewed and discussed in a public session during ICANN56. The Drafting Team has prepared a revised charter which has been forwarded to the SO/ACs with the request to identify pertinent issues, if any, that would prevent adoption. At the request of the GNSO Council leadership team, a webinar has been scheduled for 13 October to provide an overview of the proposed charter and address any possible questions. With no pertinent issues having been raised, the DT submitted the proposed charter for consideration by the different ICANN SO/ACs.

The current status of the Charter is as follows:

- ASO - no objections to current charter proposal and are ready for its adoption

Mailing list etiquette

- ⦿ Subject line should be clear. This makes it easier for members to search and respond to the thread.
- ⦿ Remember to sign with your full name
- ⦿ Be mindful of inbox overload
- ⦿ When quoting a previous email, copy selected passage only, not the entire email
- ⦿ Message to the entire list should only be sent when it contains information that is beneficial to everyone. Messages such as “thanks for the information” or “me too” should be sent to individuals rather than the entire list.
- ⦿ Administrative messages such as dial out requests, apologies or Statement of Interest issues should not be sent to the entire list
- ⦿ Do not hesitate to ask questions or comments!

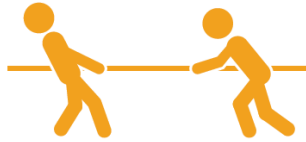

ICANN EXPECTED STANDARDS OF BEHAVIOR



Act in accordance with ICANN's Bylaws. In particular, participants undertake to act within the mission of ICANN and in the spirit of the values contained in the Bylaws.



Adhere to ICANN's conflict of interest policies.



Facilitate transparency and openness when participating in policy development and decision-making processes.



Conduct yourself in accordance with ICANN policies.



Work to build consensus with other stakeholders in order to find solutions to the issues that fall within the areas of ICANN's responsibility. The ICANN model is based on a bottom-up, consensus driven approach to policy development. Those who take part in the ICANN process must take responsibility for ensuring the success of the model by trying to build consensus with other participants.



Act in a reasonable, objective and informed manner when participating in policy development and decision-making processes. This includes regularly attending all scheduled meetings and acting in the best interest of Internet community, irrespective of personal interests and the interests of the entity to which an individual might owe their appointment.



Protect the organization's assets and ensure their efficient and effective use.



Act fairly and in good faith with other participants in the ICANN process.



Listen to the views of all stakeholders when considering policy issues. ICANN is a unique multi-stakeholder environment. Those who take part in the ICANN process must acknowledge the importance of all stakeholders and seek to understand their points of view.



Treat all members of the ICANN community equally, irrespective of nationality, gender, racial or ethnic origin, religion or beliefs, disability, age, or sexual orientation; members of the ICANN community should treat each other with civility both face to face and online.



Promote ethical and responsible behavior. Ethics and integrity are essential, and ICANN expects all stakeholders to behave in a responsible and principled way.



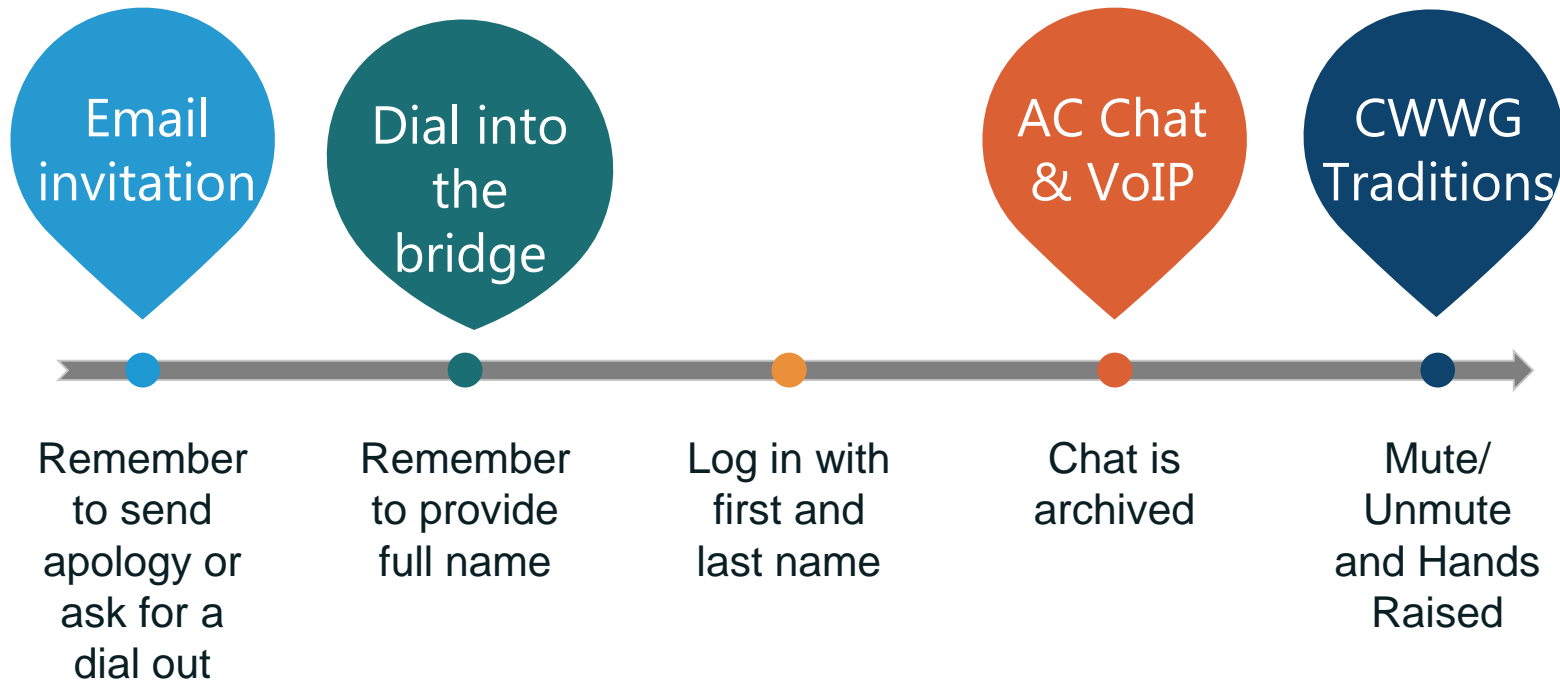
Support the maintenance of robust mechanisms for public input, accountability, and transparency so as to ensure that policy development and decision-making processes will reflect the public interest and be accountable to all stakeholders.

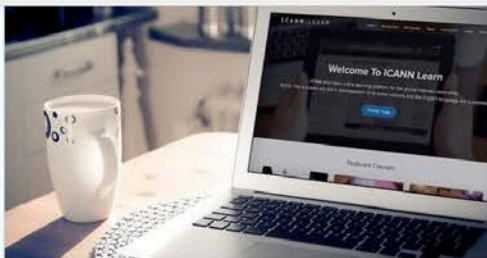

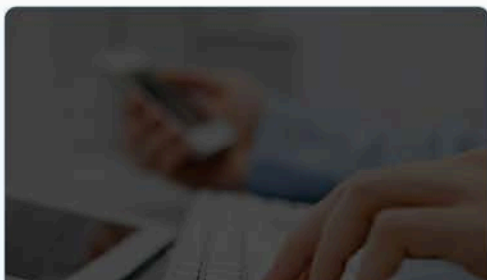

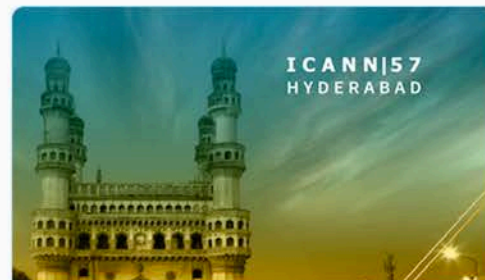
