



  - proposal to amend ICANN bylaw article 10, to review the definition of ccNSO membership and include IDN ccTLDs in the ccNSO.





## **Regional Policy Development**

Community discussions at ARIN44 in Austin, Texas later this month will focus on six recommended draft policies and four proposals

 General topics include clarifying IPv4 request and reassignment requirements, updates to IPv6 deployment block, etc.

Three proposals reached consensus at APNIC 48 in September in Chiang Mai, Thailand

The LACNIC community discussed eight proposals last week in Panama City, Panama

12 other proposals are under consideration across the remaining two Regional Internet Registry meetings for 2019:

- RIPE 79 this week in Rotterdam, the Netherlands
- AFRINIC 31 early December in Luanda, Angola

#### Third At-Large Summit (ATLAS III) – Key Activities



- The third At-Large Summit (ATLAS III) is taking place 4-7 November at ICANN66.
- ATLAS III is an assembly of future policy and outreach ambassadors.
- Nearly 60 members from across the At-Large community are participating.
- ATLAS III will provide participants with the skills required to effectively represent the best interests of the end users within ICANN, including in policy advice development.
- A series of plenaries sessions and break-out groups will provide training and interactive, hands-onpractice of key learning skills.
- A case study on the EPDP Phase 1 will serve as focus for the training.
- Post-summit activities will include ATLAS III Ambassadors being thought leaders and change agents within At-Large and ICANN.





- Recent Publications
  - RSSAC044: Report from the RSSAC October 2019 Workshop (forthcoming)
- Current Work Parties:
  - Metrics for the DNS Root Server Operators and Root Server System
  - Study of Modern Resolver Behaviors
- Root Server System (RSS) Evolution Update
  - 23 May ICANN Org opened a public comment proceeding seeking feedback for evolving the governance of the Root Server System Documents to comment include RSSAC037, the Governance Concept paper, the draft charter, operating procedures and work plan for the governance working group
  - ICANN Org considered all the comments and updated the governance concept paper
  - ICANN Board intends to take action at ICANN66

#### **Security and Stability Advisory Committee (SSAC)**

- SAC106: Comments on Evolving the Governance of the Root Server System
  - Comments on RSSAC037 and Root Server System Evolution
  - SSAC recommends that it be included as a voting member of the Governance Working Group (GWG)
  - Further recommends that the SSAC not be given any operational roles in the eventual governance model,
  - that decisions be made by consensus when possible,
  - and that governance bodies be reviewed regularly
- DNS over HTTPS / DNS over TLS
- SSAC participation in the GNSO ePDP
- Second SSAC Organizational Review
